

One Month or Less Temporary Disability Parking and Handivan Rider Request



The University's ADA Coordinator and Transportation and Parking Services authorizes temporary (one month or less) parking permits and approval to ride the Handivan to students, faculty and staff of The Ohio State University with appropriate documentation from a physician. The disability must limit or impair a major life function in accordance with the Ohio Revised Code Section 4503.44 and the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA).

Please note that the completion and submission of this document allows an individual to be considered for no more than one month of OSU temporary disability parking privileges, and a signature of certification is required from a diagnosing physician or Health Care Provider of the disability and may be subject to further evaluation and/or consultation with authorized individuals of The Ohio State University.

One Month or Less Temporary Disability Parking and Handivan Rider Form

The disability must limit or impair a major life function in accordance with the Ohio Revised Code Section 4503.44 and Americans with Disability Act (ADA).

Any disability requiring more than 1 month must obtain a temporary disability placard from the Bureau of Motor Vehicles. Information and applications can be found on the web at http://www.bmv.ohio.gov/pdf_forms/4826.pdf. Applications may also be downloaded from the BMV site and taken to any local license agency or mailed in to any of the Ohio Bureau of Motor Vehicles, PO Box 16521, Columbus, Ohio 43215-6521, along with the required processing fee of \$3.50. The disability placard will be valid for the length of time prescribed by the physician. Once this placard is received, a copy should be provided to T&P with the application for Temporary Disability parking. A temporary disability permit will be issued for the same amount of time listed on the state placard.

Temporary Disability Parking

Any disability requiring less than 1 month may fill out this form (specific dates must be included). Prior to visiting T&P, please have this form completed by yourself and your personal physician. If your personal physician is not available to complete the form, students may visit Wilce Student Health Center (292-4321). All undergraduate students granted temporary disability parking will be required to park on West Campus and utilize the Handivan Service.

Parking Privilege and Related Parking Information

Temporary disability parking permits allow parking in any general (non-reserved) surface disability space and any non-restricted "A", "B", or "C" surface space. If parked at a meter, all fees must be paid. All undergraduate students granted temporary disability parking will be required to park on West Campus and utilize the Handivan Service. The Handivan provides curb to curb service from West Campus to locations around campus. Faculty and Staff who hold an annual West Campus permit will also be issued a West Campus temporary disability permit and may use the Handivan Service. Arrangements for Handivan rides may be made once the application has been received in the T&P Office.

Please note: There are license-plate-specific reserved disability spaces throughout campus. These spaces are reserved 24 hours per day. Please do not utilize these spaces. "Restricted" spaces are defined as state vehicle spaces, loading zones, fire lanes, and other specifically designated spaces.

Handivan Paratransit Service

The Handivan is an adapted transportation service provided for students, faculty, staff, and visitors with temporary or permanent mobility impairments. This service transports wheelchair and ambulatory passengers door-to-door, both on and off campus, within University established boundaries. Handivans operate during the same hours as regular bus service. For more information or to schedule rides, please call 292-6202.
